We encourage you to also show the animals you have enrolled in this sale. However, please recognize that the buyer may decide to transport the animals before the show. In this case, we recognize it is a risk, but there are no refunds of show fees paid for each entry.

2024 SALE AGREEMENT ~ Females of Fall Sale by NCHCA ~ September 20, 2024

By participating in this consignment sale, I agree to abide by all rules regarding the sale. I understand that sale proceeds will be disbursed within a 60-day period after the sale.

Cost: I also understand that all consignments will be charged a uniform sales commission of 8% to cover shared expenses from all consignors for advertising, catalogs, sale bidding platform, etc. I agree that commission will be charged on any last bid received on the sale platform and it constitutes the basis for sale expense, which includes floor prices, pass outs, etc., and the seller will be charged 8% commission for the sale or 8% commission for buybacks, based on this number. I understand that any buy back or reserve limit must be submitted on the entry form by August 11, 2024, or I can bid on the animal and buy it back myself. I understand that entry fees (\$50 per animal and consignors must be NCHCA members) are not refundable. Any lot withdrawn after August 11, 2024, will be assessed a \$150 cancellation fee, in addition to the entry fee they already paid.

No Published Minimums: The NCHCA Sale does not and will not publish reserves or indicate if an animal has met a reserve on the sale. It is the responsibility of the seller to set a reserve limit price as outlined above, but it will not be published. Anyone found to publicly share reserve prices may be banned from participating in future sales.

No Pre-selling Animals: Anyone who uses the NCHCA Sale to promote their animal(s) and sell them before the sale, may be banned from participating in future sales and is subject to the 8% commission fee.

Ownership: I certify that I am the owner of the consigned cattle, and all statements, pedigrees, photos and video information provided is factual and in accordance with the guidelines of the American Highland Cattle Association.

Permission: I give the Females of Fall Sale presented by North Central Highland Cattle Association committee permission to use my information and the images provided to promote my submissions as they see fit.

Health Requirements: I have read and will adhere to the sale health requirements (attached). All entries must have a certified health certificate (CVI) complying with Minnesota health requirements before arriving at the sale location. Registered animals must have a legible tattoo that corresponds with registration papers. All animals must have a USDA-APHIS approved ear tag. All animals must have a negative BVD-PI test and Tuberculosis (TB) test. Animals must be from a Brucellosis-free state, have a BANGS (Brucellosis vaccine), or be tested free of Brucellosis. Pregnant animals must be confirmed in calf on the health certificate by a veterinarian. All entries must be poured with parasitological control within 10 days of the sale and date of treatment must be provided on health certificate. Any other tests you have completed and would like listed such as anaplasmosis, blue tongue and nt821, etc., please be sure to note those in the animal's entry description. These tests should also be listed on your veterinary health certificate.

Transportation/After Care: Buyers are responsible for transportation including arrangements and costs. In the event a buyer does not have transportation from the sale site arranged, I understand that animals will need to return to my farm until transportation is secured. Animals must leave the fairgrounds by Sunday, September 22, 2024. In the event your buyer is unable to transport animals, or you need to take them home, you are responsible for feeding and caring for the animal until it leaves the grounds. Please make sure to bring enough feed to last through Sunday.

USA Only: This is a USA-only live cattle sale. No live cattle will be eligible to sell to Canada.

The sale committee reserves the right to accept or reject all entries and use its discretion to pick the final lots. Photos and/or videos are due by August 11, 2024, or you may forfeit your entry with no entry refund.
