

## Highland Production Sale by NCHCA Health Requirements US Origin September 20, 2024

Requirement	Females
<b>Individual</b> Health Certificate (CVI)	This must be presented upon arrival at the sale site and will be reviewed by the onsite veterinarian on Thursday. Required tests, vaccines and pregnancy status must be listed on the CVI.
BVD-PI	Negative BVD-PI test required. Note this can be from any date as this test is good for the life of the animal.
Tuberculosis (TB)	Animal must be tested TB negative within 30 days of the sale.
Brucellosis	Animals must be from a Brucellosis-free state, have a BANGS (Brucellosis vaccine), or be tested free of Brucellosis.
External Parasites	Required parasitical control pour-on product within 10 days. Please make sure it covers sucking lice. Examples of acceptable products are Ivermectin, Dectomax, Eprinex, Cydectin, etc.
Pregnancy Examination recorded either open or Pregnant on the health certificate	Required within 30 days, if selling as pregnant.
Official Identification	Official ID (RFID, Bangs tag, silver USDA tag)
AHCA Tattoo	All animals must have an official AHCA tattoo that matches their registration papers. Tattoos must be legible.
Health Records	Seller should provide health records to new owners, such as vaccine history.

\*Some States may require certain testing for entry such as Anaplasmosis, Blue Tongue or other tests. If these tests are required for entry, the cost of these tests are the responsibility of the Buyer. Nt821 tests are recommended but are not required for the sale.
